Building Team Excellence



Most of the companies today want to harness the collective power of people working together. Leaders and managers both are convinced that the use of a team approach for running a business has a great potential. However, most of them are struggling with ways to help teams be successful. Others are only talking about it but are failing to develop team excellence.

Though there is no one format that can describe how all teams can achieve excellence, but there are some common characteristics which have been found to be existent in effective teams.

- i. Successful teams possess a clear sense of direction.
- ii. They have talented members with competencies/knowledge/skills available that are necessary to carry out the tasks at hand.
- iii. Leadership and other roles are clearly identified, and participants are how their roles fit into the game plan.
- iv. Task/s, content and process system are well planned and performed.
- v. Constructive interpersonal relationships are maintained. Issues relating to diversity, conflict management are dealt with.

VI. An active reinforcement system to reward individuals and group performance is in place.

VII. Constructive external relations with people, groups and subsystems to pursue opportunities and address threats are well identified and worked out.
